Standard IFCO Prohibitions

The following commodities are NOT acceptable for transport by IFCO UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.

This is a result of a policy decision, following the full consideration of Operational, Legal and Risk Management implications.

Animals

Bullion

Currency

Dangerous goods, hazardous or combustible materials, including asbestos, as defined by IATA or by applicable sea or road transport regulations (Drugs / Narcotics (illegal))

Firearms, parts thereof and ammunition (Firearm parts may be acceptable for carriage domestically within USA,

Human remains (including ashes)

Pornography

Any item(s), the carriage of which is prohibited by any law, regulation or statute of any federal, state or local government of any country to or through which the shipment may be carried.

4. *Max weight: 20 kgs.Import licence required. Endorsement by the State Frontier Control for Quality of Products Directorate might also be required; otherwise ship via WPX.; Otherwise ship via WPX*
5. *Max quantity: 5; Otherwise ship via WPX*
6. *DOX-passports must be stated in the description field.*
7. *Max quantity: 10 pieces.; Otherwise ship via WPX*

1. *Sanitary permit issued by the Main State Sanitary Inspector, endorsement by the State Sanitary Control Authorities required. Excise should be paid.*
2. *Health certificate from origin required. Endorsement by the National Veterinary Medical Authorities.*
3. *Contact Customer Service*
4. *Import Licence required.*
5. *Sanitary permit required, endorsement by State Sanitary Control Authorities*
6. *Sanitary permit issued by the Main State Sanitary Inspector, Endorsement by the State Sanitary Control Authorities and Import Licence required. CAS-numbers as well as chemicals names & formulas required.*
7. *Sanitary permit & endorsement required. Endorsement by the National Office for Plant Protection. Excise should be paid. Phytosanitary certificate stamped by origin required.*
8. *Sanitary permit, Endorsement by State Sanitary Control required.*
9. *Values on the invoice must be clearly divided into value of software and value of media. These values should be shown separately.*
10. *Phytosanitary certificate required, endorsement by the National Office for Plant Protection.*
11. *Phytosanitary Certificate required, endorsement by the National office for plant protection;*

Sanitary permit, endorsement by the State Sanitary control required.

12. *Import Licence issued by Ministry of Health required.*

13. *Excise also should be paid. For customs tariff commodity code 95043000 Import licence required.*

14. *Import licence, Sanitary permit required (all this refers to the plant protection preparations).*

15. *Import licence could be required.*

16. *Excise should be paid.*

17. *Some of these items might need endorsements or permissions. Please specify.*

18. *Certificate from the State Commission for communications required.*

19. *If in transit; "ship spares in transit" and name of the ship should be clearly stated on the invoice; addressed to registered shipping company/agency.*

20. *Sanitary permit required for working & safe items.*

21. *Phytosanitary certificate required, endorsement by the National Office for plant protection. Excise should be paid.*

Service Impact Notes

Original typewritten invoice is mandatory. Faxes or photocopies are not acceptable. Terms of delivery (Incoterms '90) must be stated on invoice.d). Fully detailed description of goods required with value for each item. Currency code must be clearly stated. Private persons can only receive items for personal use.
