2. *CITES certificate must be provided by origin for wild animal skins (Washington Convention).*
3. *Ministry authorization provided by consignee required for clearance.*
4. *Invoice to specify if shipped for inter company data exchange, otherwise the value of the medium and the information/software must be stated separately on the invoice.*
5. *Certificate of Origin required. Consignee to certify that goods adhere to the French norms.*
6. *Import license may be required if goods manufactured outside EFTA countries. Certificate of Origin required. Paris & Lyon Gateways do not require Country of Origin, if declared value <625 USD. Contact Import Gateway with full details before shipping. No license may be required if articles mutilated or marked SAMPLES by shipper.*
7. *Non-perishable only. .*
8. *If made of precious metals & stones: prohibited.*
9. *Goods must conform to the established norms of European Union (EU).*

Temporary importations : Consignee must have a broker in France to clear the shipments. WPX paperwork : all WPX dutiable shipments (valued above 28 USD) must be accompanied by three original copies of the invoice and three copies of WPX HAWB.
